



Partner Agency Program

Provides food sourcing and resources to over 100 pantries, soup kitchens, churches and other organizations working to ease hunger and increase accessibility to food assistance.

Mobile Market Distribution

Provides 25-40 pounds of groceries at various sites throughout Lake & Porter counties. Mobile Market food distributions are held 4-7 times per week serving 100-500 families each time.

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

Provides monthly shelf stable meals to 1,600 food insecure seniors on fixed incomes. Subsidized by the Indiana State Department of Health, the Food Bank has the largest CSFP program in the state.

Food Is Medicine

Provides medically attained groceries to neighbors facing food insecurity through a partnership including Franciscan Health, Methodist, HealthLinc and Community Health Network.

Pantry Pack

Roughly 25 pounds of groceries provided monthly to targeted populations in partnership with agencies like Tradewinds, Department of Child Services and Lake County Juvenile Center.

Backpack On The Go

Provides food assistance to over 10,000 Northwest Indiana children per year at local schools and Boys & Girls locations.

Veteran Support

Operation Full Pack serves area veterans facing food insecurity.

Retail Rescue

In partnership with Feeding America and retailers throughout Lake & Porter Counties, the Food Bank rescues large volume of food daily.

NWI Hunger Coalition

Sponsored by the Northwest Indiana Funders Collaborative, the Coalition unites local charitable food organizations to maximize hunger relief efforts to food insecure individuals and families.

SNAP Outreach

Provides application assistance to help individuals access federal food benefits. The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) increases food security and stimulates the local economy.

Order Ahead Lockers

An online registration systems allows access to 24 hour assistance through referral locker system. Developed by Feeding America and its network of Food Banks. It makes it easier for people to receive food assistance they need, when they need it.

Homeless Street Outreach

Annually, emergency food assistance & case management services provided to 8,000 individuals experiencing homelessness.

GROW Job Training Program

Provides on-site job training for individuals involved in the justice system in partnership with the Center for Workforce Innovations.
